



Here we have systems that are all around us that already support and illustrate the active principles that are found in the "Inverted Universal Globe Spin Theory". They demonstrate the creation of the "Coriolis Effect", "Vortexes" and "Inward Directed Pulling Force", which is just another way of looking at an "Inward Directed Center of Gravity".

The first part illustrates the exact principle at play, where one system above is rotating in a different direction as the system on the ground, creating a vortex and a "falling pressure" towards the center of the storm system.

The second part of the illustration diagrams how two inverted systems that are rotating in opposing directions create at its center a downward pulling force.

In an "Inverted Universal Globe Spin Theory" system, you are applying these very principles.
